

## CONSUMER INFORMATION TRUCK-CAMPER LOADING

This information is provided in fulfillment of the requirement by the United States Government, Department of Transportation, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, that "every manufacturer of trucks that are capable of accommodating slide-in campers, manufactured on or after April 1, 1973, shall provide . . . . at the time of original purchase to the first person who purchases the truck" . . . . information on Truck-Camper Loading.

Figure 1 below illustrates the dimensions describing the forward and rearward limits of the zone in which the center of gravity (C.G.) of a slide-in camper must be located to provide satisfactory vehicle handling and to prevent overload of the front and rear axles.




Figure 2 below illustrates a proper match between truck and camper. Note that the camper center of gravity (C.G.) falls within the specified zone.
