- 1. Raise the vehicle on a hoist.
- 2. Position a transmission jack in place.
- 3. Remove support cushion stud nuts (6).



- 4. Raise rear of transmission until cushion studs (6) clear frame.
- 5. Remove the nuts holding the support cushion (5) to the transmission support bracket (8).
- 6. Remove support cushion (5).



7. Remove the bolts (3) holding the transmission support to the bracket (4).



- 8. Remove the bolts (7) holding the transmission support to the transmission.
- 9. Remove the transmission support (8).



- 10. Remove the nuts (1) from the transmission bracket.
- 11. Remove the bracket (3) from the transmission.
