

BATTERIES

In TDR Issue 99, pages 108-111, writer Moses Ludel talked about his 2005 Turbo Diesel and its batteries that lasted 13 years.

His tips: I credit the longevity to three proactive measures:

- 1) Methodical use of a Battery Tender,
- 2) Adding distilled water to an allegedly 'maintenance free' battery, and
- 3) Use of the engine block heater whenever practical in wintertime.

By the way – if you have one "bad" battery, chances are the other is likely to fail. The term for this is "cannibalization" and it is just that. The good battery cannot compensate for the bad cell in the other unit and it falters, too.



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BRAKES

Back in 2004 the Turbo Diesel Register folks (author James Walker) did a series of articles on your truck's brake system. The full contents can be found at the TDR's website, left control panel (member-only area), *The Perfect Collection*, "Brake Systems in Plain English."

A question from the author, "What stops your truck: big brake kit, upgraded brake pads, slotted or drilled rotors, high temperature fluid?"

Answer: All of the above upgrades can help. However, the contact patch between your tires and the road stops the vehicle. (The big brake kit does very little to help you on ice.)

BRAKE FLUID

Brake fluid is hygroscopic. Big word: tending to absorb moisture from the air. This is good.

Really? How so?

Because brake fluid absorbs water into its solution, the local concentration levels are typically low enough that corrosion of brake system components is minimal. This assumes that you change the fluid and/or monitor its condition.

Knowing that maintenance is required, how do you "monitor" the fluid?

Easy, this brake fluid test tool will tell you the moisture percentage.

0-2% - 0kay

3-4% - Not so much, time for a change.

Automatic Transmission Fluid Change

In a standard change of the automatic transmission fluid (ATF), only about five quarts of the old fluid can be drained out. To get a complete change (for example, when switching to synthetic fluid), disconnect the transmission cooler line at the radiator, cut and fit a piece of hose to the coupler end, and place the other end in a five-gallon container.

Put your truck in NEUTRAL with the brake on and start the engine. ATF will flow into the container. As soon as the flow begins to dwindle, immediately shut off the engine.

Measure the fluid that you removed using this all-the-fluid maintenance technique. Change your transmission filter. Reattach the cooler line and refill the transmission with the same amount of fluid that came out of the transmission. Project complete.

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TURBOCHARGERS

My daughter and I have an understanding about understanding. It goes something like this: If you can't explain something in terms that a five-year-old can comprehend, you really don't know what you are talking about.

So, how about an explanation on the basic operation of a turbocharger.

- "This is an easy one." The daughter says.
- · Purchase two kid's pinwheels.
- Place them back-to-back and imagine that they are attached on a common axis.
- Blow on one side (exhaust) and the other side (intake) spins, grabbing air and compressing it.
- Now build two snail-shaped housings around the pinwheels so that the intake air and exhaust air both have a direct path into and out of the pinwheels.
- The more you blow and the exhaust side spins, the more air is pulled in on the intake side. Now you can add more fuel on the intake side, causing more exhaust to spin the pinwheel even faster. (More "boost.") The limit becomes an engine that can only "breathe" so much air.

Got it?

Glad I could help.

Extreme Cold Weather Operation



For extreme cold weather operation if you install a winter front radiator cover on your Turbo Diesel, it must have a minimum one square foot opening in its center for radiator and intercooler airflow.

This tip is from the Cummins, Engine Operations Manual.
